Introduction

IVAO Ukraine special operations department invites all of you to participate in the Chornobyl firefighting operation on the 13th of August 16:30-19:00 UTC.

According to legend, due to the hot and dry summer, the forests in the Chernobyl sanctuary and in the area of the Desna military training ground, which is located on the right bank of the Kyiv reservoir, caught fire. In this regard, the Ministry of Emergency Situations and the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine form fire groups of medium/heavy aircraft, medium/heavy helicopters, seaplanes and organize the Chornobyl firefighting operation. The task is to eliminate and prevent the spread of fire. The Kyiv/Boryspil International Airport (UKBB) was chosen as the aviation gathering place.

Location of the Operation

Chornobyl firefighting operation is carried out on the territory of Ukraine in the Kyiv FIR (UKBV). Firefighting will take place in two restricted areas: UKR999 and UKR998.

At the time of the event, two NOTAMs are introduced:


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Firefighting

Aircraft perform firefighting in the UKR999 restricted area (Chernobyl reserve), helicopters in the UKR998 area (Desna training ground). Each pilot must perform a **minimum of two drops** over fires.

• Aircrafts:

After takeoff, maintain runway heading and climb to 4000 feet, then wait for vectoring to point NANIR (505000N0301600E). After point NANIR (505000N0301600E), the ATC will vector you to the firefighting area. Firefighting will be carried out at an altitude of 600 feet. After completing the first firefighting, climb 7000 feet and wait for vectoring to Boryspil airport for additional water intake.

Seaplanes: after the first drop, expect vectoring to the area of the Kyiv Reservoir for the next water intake.

• Helicopters:

After takeoff, maintain runway heading and climb to 4000 feet, then wait vectoring to point ARPOD (508220N0303852E). After the ARPOD point (508220N0303852E), the ATC will direct you to the fire extinguishing area. Firefighting must be performed at a minimum altitude of 300 feet. After completing the first firefighting, fly to the Kyiv reservoir area to perform a water intake. After the second drop, expect vectoring to Boryspil



If you have correctly installed the additional scenery, then a person object will appear next to taxiways 18 and 19 in Boryspil (UKBB).



- Pilots may communicate with each other on <u>Discord HQ-SOD</u>;
- An hour before the start of the event, information about the weather forecast at Boryspil airport (UKBB) and in the firefighting area will be sent to the participants' mails. Half an hour before the start of the event, information about the current weather at the Boryspil airport and in the firefighting area will be sent to the participants' mail;
 - Pilots must sign up in advance to take part in the event on the IVAO SO department website;
 - Pilots participating in the event will receive 2 SO points;
 - ATC participating in the event will receive 2 SO points;
- ATC who participate in the event must book their position in advance on the website of the IVAO Special Operations Department and in the IVAO booking system;

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Stands for aircrafts (Airport Boryspil)



Apron S and G will be used for special operation.

Blue (apron S) – stands for medium aircrafts, and medium/heavy helicopters.

Green (apron G) – stands for heavy aircrafts.
