1. GENERAL

1.1 Overview

Hellenic Division, Special Operations and HAFv organizes the Tiger Meet Event for the 2nd year on **22nd June 2024**

Squadron "TIGER" History

335 is the oldest Greek Squadron established in October 1941 during WWII in airport Akir in Palestine due to German - Italian occupation in Greece at this time. Greek Royal Air Force Pilots escaped from Greece firstly trained by RAF.

In the beginning, Squadron was equipped by Hurricane IIB/IIC but since December 1943 by Spitfire VB/VC operating in North Africa, Italy, Yugoslavia, Albania and occupied Greece (Crete, Cyclades and Dodecanese islands). During WWII conducted 8500 operational flight hours plus 12000 training flight hours and lost 18 pilots.

In June 1947, Squadron was equipped with Spitfire IX, in October 1953 by F-84G and RT-33A, in Autumn 1957 by F-84F, in May 1965 by F-104G and since April 1993 until 2009 by A-7E.

Nowadays is equipped by F-16M Block 52+ Advanced.

<u>Missions:</u> Will be conducted Interception, Dive on Ground Target missions and CPMs (Combat Profile Missions).

Aircraft Types: Fighter Jets or Operational Trainer Jets.

All aircraft must not be equipped by bombs or missiles. Also, in all missions Master Arm will be in Safe or Simulate Mode.















LGRX PARKING POSITIONS






.8 Ground Target Attack

DIVE ON GROUND TARGET - GROUND TARGET ATTACK

Jinking = Horizontal sequential turns L-R-L or R-L-R. e.t.c. 90 degrees changing bank at the rule of Alt \times 1M' of Alt \times 1M'/2 in seconds
