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INTRODUCTION

It's the most important event for the SpecOps dept. of the Spanish division this year. That's why we held this event in LETO coinciding with the event 7 hours in LEMD, Madrid Barajas Airport - Adolfo Suarez, they are at a distance of 6nm.

During 2h, LEMD and LETO will live together with real flights.

For our SpecOps event we have created missions of different characteristics so that everyone can find their favorite flight.

Having so close to Barajas with a large number of airplanes, you must prepare your flight very well.

COMMPLAN

There are some flights that could be controlled by both civilian and military ATCs, others will be exclusive of military controllers.

If our plan works we will have covered all the dependencies of Torrejon and Madrid Mil. In addition to supporting us in the civil controllers.

Aircraft departing from LETO.

They will contact LETO_M_TWR if connected, or the superior military unit, LETO_M_APP or LECM_M_CTR. Who will give you the exit instructions.

Aircraft arriving at LETO.

Within the LEDs the responsibility will be LECM_M_CTR.

The aircrafts will be contact with LECM_M_CTR and "Madrid Military" will demolish the airplanes according to the approach to be made.

Inside LEDs, LECM_M_CTR callsing will be "PEGASO".

Outside LEDs, LECM M CTR callsing will be "Madrid Mil"





PILOT INFORMATION

We have prepared a few missions with the aircraft that normally operate in Torrejon AFB. In addition we will put 16 slots for aircraft that operate outside of these missions. Always fly according to the GAT. They will be provided with a PPR and slot for LETO arrival and departure. Aircraft that fly out of these missions or slots, may not take off or if they are on arrival they are sent to an alternative outside the Madrid TMA, mainly LEZG, Zaragoza AFB.

The QRA pilots should be listening at LECM_M_CTR who will order their takeoff. Once ordered, they will contact LETO_M_TWR if it is connected to request immediate take-off. They must take off in no more than 15 minutes.

The missions are as follows:

- 5 fire-fighting amphibious aircraft, CL215 / CL415, approx. 1h 30 'of flight. FS9, FSX or P3D simulators. LED132
- 2 Fighters, escort mission, 1h, they will escort the LINCE.
- 1 VIP transport A310, VIP Mission, 1h, The aircraft will be escorted by 2 fighters. LETO LESJ
- 1 transport F900, Transport mission, 1h, LETO LEST
- 1 Tanker B707 / A330, AAR mission, 1h 40 ', LETO LED104 LETO
- 2 Fighters, AAR mission + A / A training, 1h 30', LETO LED104 LETO
- 4 Fighters, AAR mission + A / A training, 1h 15', LETO LED104 LETO
- 1 HELO, Police mission, 45', LETO LETO
- 1 C130 / A400, transport mission, 1h, LEZG LETO
- 2 Fighters, QRA mission, 1h, LETO LETO
- 8 Slots for planes arriving from outside, GAT, XXXX LETO. Necessary PPR and SLOT.
- 8 Slots for planes that go out, GAT, LETO XXXX. Necessary PPR and SLOT.
- 1 aircraft. MEDEVAC mission, 1h, LEZL LETO
- 1 C130 / A400, Transport mission, 1h LETO LEZG

When the event approaches, some mission packages will be sent with the necessary information and additional scenery to carry out the missions.

Primary arrivals in LETO are ILS-Z rwy 22. If the wind component is more of 10kt in tail proceed with circling to land to rwy 04. If you want to do another approximation using the LEMD locators, these approximations may not be approved, depending on the congestion of LEMD APP

Is possible, if LETO is saturated the possible arrivals can will diverted to LEZG. Always following the military ATC instructions.

ATC INFORMATION

The positions will be the standard ones and will be operated in a normal way.

Once the missions are closed, flight information will be sent to the ATCs.

The VIP flight and MEDEVAC as far as possible will have to facilitate the operation.

The active positions for the event will be:

LECM_M_CTR --> APC + CAO LETO_M_APP --> APC + CAO LETO M TWR --> ADC + CAO

LEZG_APP --> ADC Recommended CAO Knowledge
LEZG_TWR --> AS3 Recommended CAO Knowledge

Remember that to control you must be in possession of the CAO rating for the positions mentioned above.

ATCs who don't belong to the Spanish division must be in possession of the GCA for Spain.
